

Student safety is a significant priority at Northeastern Illinois University. This policy sets forth the requirements and responsibilities of the University when a student who resides in an on-campus residential facility has been determined to be missing.


This policy complies with the federal requirements established by the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008 (HEOA) regarding missing students who reside in on-campus housing. HEOA requires NEIU to establish an effective Missing Student notification policy and procedures for students who reside in The Nest -campus housing.

This policy affects all members of the University community.

Student: any person enrolled in any class or program at NEIU.

**Missing Student:** a student is defined as missing once the NEIU Police Department or a local law enforcement agency is notified and initiate a formal missing person investigation.




## Students age 18 and above and Emancipated Minors
