The 2024-2025 FREE Application for Federal Student Aid and the Illinois Alternative Application (RISE Act) are open! Students and those contributing information to the FAFSA will need an FSA

- ID this includes undocumented parents. Steps to get started:
 - 1. Ensure anyone contributing information to the FAFSA has an FSA ID or FAFSA Account
 - 2. Student logs into FAFSA and completes student portion
 - 3. Student invites contributors (e.g., parents, spouse) to log into FAFSA to complete contributor portion
