- o NEIUhas modified its original plan to provide 500-bed housing on the Bryn Mawr block and 300bed housing on the current campus. After listening to community feedback and consulting with local architects, it will now pursue 400-bed housing in each of the two locations.
- Northeastern will work wit h American Campus Communities (ACC), a national developer of student housing, to design, build and manage the financing of the student residence halls. Jim Curtin, a local architect hired by ACC, shared renderings of previous student housing projects that he, his firm and ACC have overseen.
- o President Hahs encouraged members to seek input from their respective organizations that would help the University shape a traffic-
