



NEIU has modified its original plan to provide 500-bed housing on the Bryn Mawr block and 300-bed housing on the current campus. After listening to community feedback and consulting with local architects, it will now pursue 400-bed housing in each of the two locations. Northeastern will work with American Campus Communities (ACC), a national developer of student housing, to design, build and manage the financing of the student residence halls. Jim Curtin, a local architect hired by ACC, shared renderings of previous student housing projects that he, his firm and ACC have overseen. President Hahs encouraged members to seek input from their respective organizations that would help the University shape a traffic-

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
